Items Accepted:

- Tires..... Limit of 4 passenger vehicle tires per household at no charge; \$2 per tire charge for more than four tires disposed. Cash only. Maximum of 8 tires accepted per household.
- Metal..... Free of gas, oil, freon and batteries. Items such as lawn mowers, steel pipe, washers, dryers, stoves, refrigerators, air conditioners and microwaves.
- Trash..... Items such as furniture, mattresses, wood (**bundled, boxed, bagged, with a 50lb. maximum, no more than 4 feet in length**).

Electronic items such as computers, computer accessory machines and televisions will be accepted this year.
