Items Accepted:

Tires..... Limit of 4 tires per household at no charge; \$2 per tire charge for more than four tires disposed. Cash only. Maximum of 8 tires accepted per household. Non-standard sizes are \$5 each. Large tractor tires are \$10 each.

Metal Free of gas, oil, freon and batteries. Items such as lawn mowers, steel pipe, washers, dryers, stoves, refrigerators, air conditioners.

Trash Items such as furniture, mattresses, and wood (bundled, boxed, or bagged, with a 50lb. maximum, no more than 4 feet in length).

No hazardous materials or garbage will be accepted. This includes, but is not limited to, paint, car batteries, aerosol cans, propane bottles, food.

Electronic items such as computers, computer accessory machines, televisions and microwaves will NOT be accepted this year. Please see the alternate options in this newsletter.

Limit of one pickup load per household.

In order to participate in the Carroll Township Spring Clean-up, individuals must provide a valid driver's license with a current address in Carroll Township.

BROWNAWELL MILL TO BE REMOVED

The Brownawell mill located on SR 34 (Spring Road) at the intersection of Mill Road is owned by the Historical Society of Perry County. They have made the difficult decision to remove the mill as it is no longer structurally sound, and the property would not sustain parking for visitors if it were repaired, which would also be quite costly. The society originally intended to move the mill to the site of the Drumgold Farm to permit visitors to enjoy it with the other buildings on site. However, the cost to move the structure was prohibitive, and given the structural condition, they decided to tear down the mill and sell the lumber to a group that will repurpose it. The funds received for the sale will go to the repair and maintenance of other properties owned by the group.

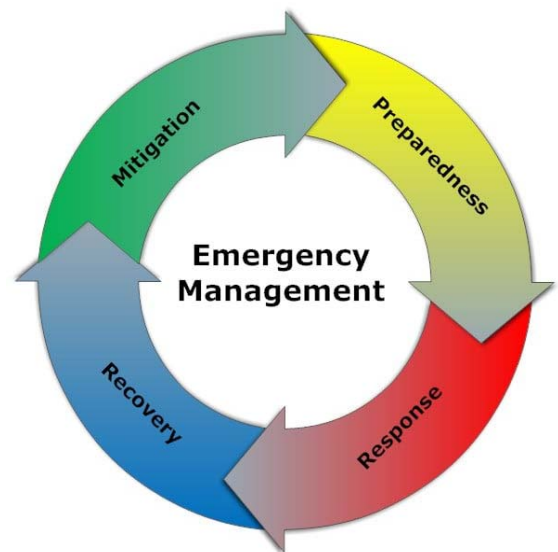
HELP EMERGENCY SERVICES FIND YOUR HOME!

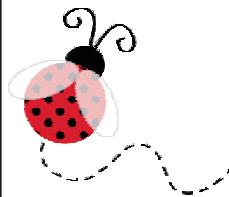
